Report to the Industrial Heartlands Trail Coalition (7/14/2016)
Report to the Erie to Pittsburgh Trail Alliance (7//21/2016)

July 7, 2016

Fleming Park Improvement Project: Project was not funded in FY 2015/16. DCED suggested the application be resubmitted (with another \$100 Application Fee) for consideration at September CFA meeting. Application has been resubmitted to the DCED.

Oil Creek Waterways Feasibility Study: (Crawford and Venango County project). Working closely with Venango and Crawford County Planning Commissions and Commissioners on a cooperative agreement for the Water Trail Manager (a requirement to be a PA Water Trail). To facilitate the creation of a water trail map/guide, meetings and site visits along Oil Creek have been completed, size of water trail map, cost, funding and organization that will print the map have been determined. We are gathering final data to apply for designation as a PA Water Trail to the State.

Bicycle PA Representative in Titusville: In late May TRA brought Bill Hoffman of Bicycle PA to Titusville to evaluate / recommend additional Bicycle PA routes, in and around Titusville that would connect to existing Bicycle PA Routes. The purpose is to promote cycletouring as well as economic development for multiple communities in NWPA. Brought together a group of regional community leaders, tourism agents, long-distance cyclists, outdoor recreation experts and PennDOT representatives to meet with Mr. Hoffman and further discuss this project. A formal report will be reviewed by the group in preparation for next steps. Also, he reviewed the proposed trail to town route from the QCT into and through Titusville, providing feedback. Titusville Trail Towne Master Plan: Meetings and discussions are underway regarding gateway, motorist and trail user signage. This Signage Project is listed as a Top Priority in the Master Plan.

City of Titusville Park and Recreation:
