Resolutions #1 – Changing the web site hosting provider for easier maintainability and lower costs

Whereas: The current web site is costing EPTA money.

Whereas: The current web site has a limit of four pages.

Whereas: The contract for the current web site is about to expire.

Therefore: Authorize the web site committee with the approval of the executive committee to enter into a contract with Roy Weil Consulting. Said contract to include a WordPress site with site content to be maintained by others, hosted at a national hosting service. Roy Weil Consulting will do this in exchange for a footer plug for Freewheeling Easy.

Note: This creates a conflict of interest issue between Roy Weil and EPTA.

Resolutions #2 – Create a PayPal account to accept donations.

Whereas: It is desired to provide a page for donations, a possible page for item sales and other pages to accrue money.

Whereas: the Treasurer has no objections to handling this account and the money.

Therefore: Authorize the treasurer in conjunction with the web site committee to set up a PayPal account for EPTA.
