PeopleForBikes Community Grant Program Deadline July 3, 2015

PeopleForBikes accepts grant applications from non-profit organizations with a focus on bicycling, active transportation, or community development, from city or county agencies or departments, and from state or federal agencies working locally. PeopleForBikes focuses most grant funds on bicycle infrastructure projects such as bike paths, lanes, trails, and bridges; end-of-trip facilities such as bike racks, bike parking, and bike storage, and several other categories. The Trail Volunteer Fund provides grants to purchase tools, materials, and supplies to be used by [volunteer trail projects](#) that create, maintain, or enhance the network of trails suitable for bicycle touring in western Pennsylvania and interconnected trails in nearby areas. In this way, the Fund celebrates and encourages the volunteers whose work has made such valuable contributions to western Pennsylvania's growing network of motor-free trails. The application process is simple, and there are four deadlines for applications per year - March 1, June 1, September 1 and December 1.
