



**EPTA Update  
April, 2016**

- The University of Pittsburgh, Titusville campus has a growing bike share program in place, administered by Campus Police and supported by the Athletic Director and the Physical Therapy Program. TATA is discussing possible collaborative programming with the campus.
- Crawford County Commissioners have expressed interest in trail activities within the county; specifically the EPT, and are becoming more active participants.
- Titusville Area School District Middle and High School PE classes are assisting with the annual cleanup of the QCT.
- TATA continues to work with Drake Well and PennDOT on proposed safety improvements for the Jersey Bridge Trailhead. A painted crosswalk will hopefully be installed this spring/summer.

- TATA continues to advocate for completion of the Queen City Trail (QCT) from its current endpoint at Martin St. to Hydetown, utilizing the currently engineered trail plans as much as possible. Titusville Redevelopment Authority and the City of Titusville are re-considering the engineered route, including the former Trolley Line, which was chosen by the public and TATA as a preferred route during the public meetings. TRA/City are also seeking funding for a trail spur from the QCT terminus north on S. Martin St. to the downtown gateway at Fleming Park, which is also the site of the seasonal Titusville Open-Air Market and the location of a bike fix-it station. This park is also awaiting potential funding for renovation.
