Following these events, TATA has been reviewing the trail and route conditions to identify safety concerns and areas in need of improvement and is formulating recommendations for the appropriate entities responsible for these sections of trail, roadway or sidewalk.

- Fleming Park Trailhead enjoyed extensive activity this summer as Titusville Renaissance, Inc. facilitated the Titusville Open-Air Market at this trailhead. Trail users were welcomed to the many special functions and activities which were held in conjunction with the market, and the new bike fix-it station in the park saw increasing use as bikers became acquainted with it. Bikers, walkers and runners in the park are becoming a more common occurrence due to the variety of market activities held from June through October.
- TATA continues to advocate for completion of the Queen City Trail from its current endpoint at Martin St. to Hydetown, utilizing the currently engineered trail plans as much as possible.
